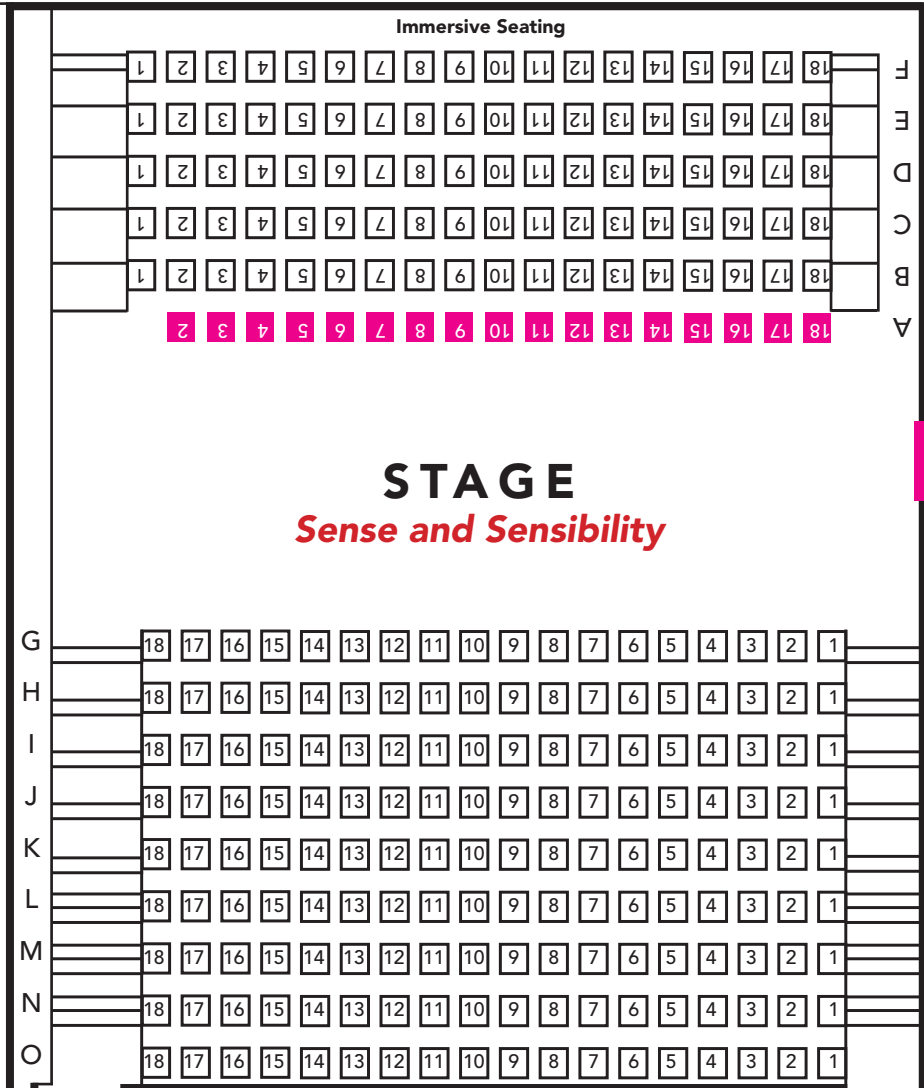

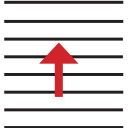

BRATTON THEATER

Bratton Theater offers 269 assigned seats. It is air-conditioned; we recommend you dress accordingly. Food and drink (except water) is not permitted inside the building except during Brown Bag lectures.

The Institution provides regularly scheduled complimentary transportation service in the Main Lot and on the grounds, daily from 7:40 a.m. to 8 p.m. during the nine-week summer assembly season. There are additional hours during evening mainstage performances. The North Bus and the Lake Tram both stop at Bratton Theater.

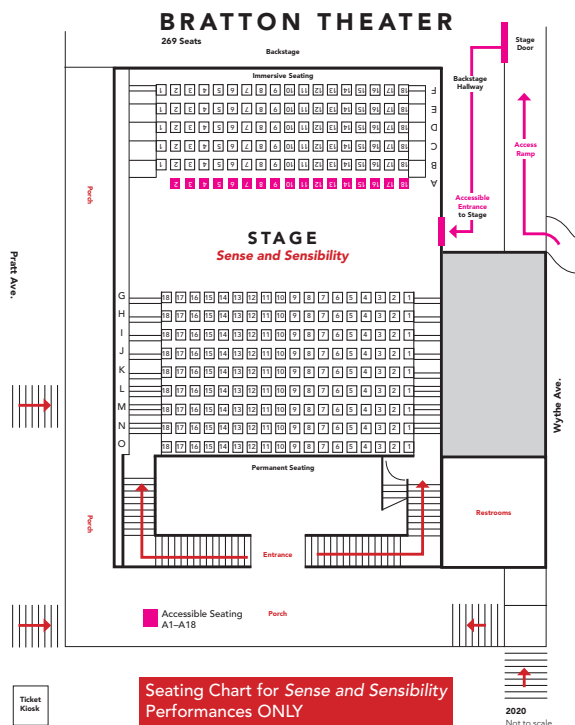
Accessibility Information

While access to Bratton Theater's main entrance from Pratt Avenue requires navigating several sets of stairs, guests with mobility challenges can easily enter the front lobby area using the ramp at the rear of the building on Wythe Avenue.

There is a limited number of short-term accessible parking spaces to the rear of Norton Hall, on Root Avenue, and in the Main Lot. A valid state-issued accessible parking permit is required to park in these spaces, and standard parking rates apply.

In this venue, we provide a Radio Frequency (RF) Assistive Listening System. Bring your own equipment or use our complimentary equipment, available for loan during the performance. Ask an usher about the Event Loan Program.
