

B. Development Council.

The Development Council is a standing committee of both the Chautauqua Foundation Board of Directors and the Chautauqua Institution Board of Trustees. ~~It-and-~~ serves as the primary interface between the two ~~organizations-on-the-issue-of-philanthropy~~relative to the development interests of the Institution and the Foundation and serves as the primary resource to the development staff of the Foundation for the delivery of philanthropic resources to advance the interests of the Institution. The Development Council shall discuss, evaluate, and recommend policies and actions to the Chautauqua Foundation and Institution Boards on all matters affecting the philanthropic development of Chautauqua. The Board Chair shall be a member of the Development Council. The Board Chair shall appoint ~~two to three additional four~~ members of the Development Council from among the Board of Trustees. The Board Chair shall appoint the Chair of the Development Council. ~~The Chair of the Development Council shall be a member of the Board of Trustees.~~ Each member appointed pursuant to this section shall sit until he or she resigns, is no longer a member of the Board of Trustees, or is replaced by the Board Chair. The Development Council is designated as a Committee of the Corporation.
