Chautauqua Institution is located in the southwestern corner of New York state. From the New York State Thruway (Interstate 90), take Exit 60, then Route 394 east. From the Southern Tier Expressway (Interstate 86), if eastbound, take Exit 7, then Route 33 north, and Route 394 east. If westbound, take Exit 8, then Route 394 west.

The Courses

The Lake

Designed by legendary golf architect Donald Ross, the Lake Course is characterized by open tee shots and demanding approaches to small, often steeply sloped greens. Ross designed over 400 courses, including the famed Pinehurst No. 2, site of the 2005 and 2014 U.S. Open, and Oak Hill, site of the 2013 PGA Championship.

The Hill

Xen Hassenplug, who also worked on both the Pittsburgh Field Club and Augusta National, designed the scenic Hill Course. With commanding views of both Chautauqua Lake and the rolling hills of the surrounding countryside, this course rewards good shot placement and features tree-lined fairways, frequent dog-legs and small but more gently sloped greens.

Clubhouse and Pro Shop

Our clubhouse offers complete banquet facilities for up to 250 guests. With views to the course and an outdoor patio, it's the perfect choice for your wedding, special event or business meeting. It's also ideal for pre- and post-tournament gatherings. With two outstanding courses to choose from, when you're planning your next charity golf event, think Chautauqua Golf Club.

And don't forget to visit the Double Eagle, with food and drink by La Familia. Named for Gene Sarazen's famous shot at No. 10 Lake, it's a great spot to gather with friends and foursomes.

The Learning Center at the Chautauqua Golf Club

Our Learning Center is a complete teaching and practice facility. Situated on 25 scenic acres overlooking Chautauqua Lake, the center boasts a 300-yard driving range; two putting greens; a chipping green with fairway, rough and bunker approaches; three practice holes; a support building with indoor teaching spaces, patio and bathrooms; and parking.

Intended to serve golfers of all ages and skill levels, the Learning Center is a non-intimidating environment that's ideal for families, school golf teams, youth groups and community agencies, as well as individuals. An extensive curriculum of group clinics, junior golf camps and outstanding private instruction is led by PGA teaching professional David Wedzik. Contact the pro shop for scheduling details and instruction fees.

All members of the Chautauqua Golf Club receive full access to the Learning Center facility as part of their regular membership.

Learning Center-only memberships are also available, or pay a daily fee. Unlimited range balls are available to everyone using the Learning Center.
